Metal Cans: Tin/Aluminum cans, pop cans, soup tins. (*no scrap metal*)

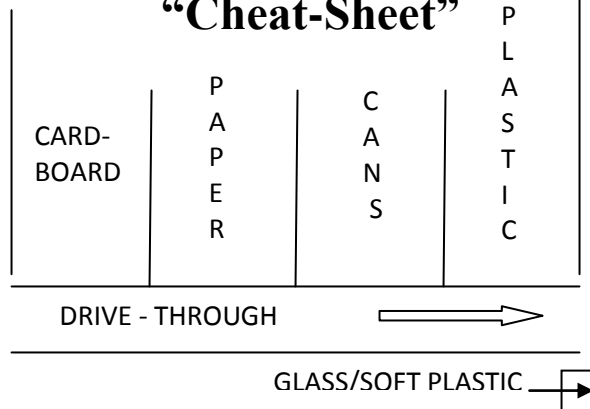
Paper: Newspaper/magazines, shredded paper, boxboard, egg cartons

Cardboard: Empty corrugated boxes

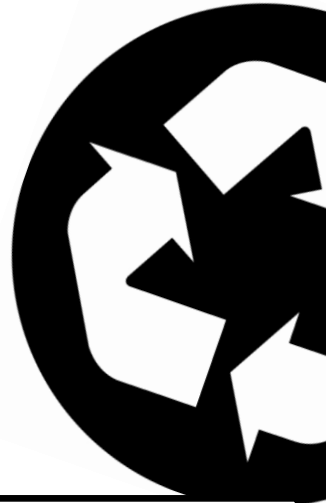
Soft Plastic: Plastic bags, plastic bubble wrap

Glass: Clear/coloured glass jars or bottles (*no broken window glass*)

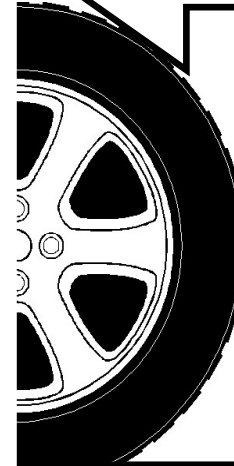
