



TOWNSHIP OF STRONG FIRE PERMIT BURNING RULES

1. BURNING WILL BE ALLOWED FROM 2 HRS BEFORE SUNSET TO 2 HRS AFTER SUNRISE. DAY TIME BURNING IS NOT ALLOWED WITH THIS PERMIT.
2. MATERIAL TO BE BURNED SHALL BE LIMITED TO WOOD OR BY-PRODUCTS OF WOOD.
3. FIRE SHALL BE NO MORE THAN 2 CUBIC METRES OF MATERIAL AT ANY ONE TIME.
4. ENSURE THAT MEANS OF EXTINGUISHING THE FIRE IS AVAILABLE AT ALL TIMES.
5. NO BURNING IN WINDS GREATER THAN 20 KPA.
6. NO OPEN AIR BURNING SHALL BE MAINTAINED WHEN THE WIND IS IN SUCH DIRECTION OR INTENSITY SO AS TO CAUSE A DECREASE IN VISIBILITY ON ANY HIGHWAY OR ROADWAY OR CAUSE RAPID SPREAD OF FIRE THROUGH GRASS OR A BRUSH AREA.
7. **PERMITTEE IS RESPONSIBLE** FOR ANY DAMAGE TO PROPERTY OR INJURY TO PERSONS OCCASIONED BY THE SAID FIRE.
8. **PERMITTEE IS LIABLE FOR ALL COSTS INCURRED BY THE FIRE DEPARTMENT WHEN CALLED TO EXTINGUISH THE SAID FIRE.**
9. PERMIT CAN BE CANCELLED AT ANY TIME BY THE FIRE CHIEF OR HIS DELEGATE.
10. ANY PERSON WHO CONTRAVENES ANY PROVISION OF THIS BY-LAW IS GUILTY OF AN OFFENCE AND IS SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE PROVINCIAL OFFENCES ACT.
11. PERMITTEE MUST HAVE A SHOVEL/SPADE, RACK, CHARGED GARDEN HOSE OR PAILS OF WATER (2 X 5 gallons) AT THE BURNING SITE IN CASE FIRE GETS OUT OF CONTROL. YOU MUST BE BACK 30 FEET FROM ALL STRUCTURES, BUSH OR DEBRIS.
